Important rules you sign up to:

The Annual Subscription will be due on 31 January. Any member in arrears by 28 February will no longer be a member of the club.

Club members wishing to invite members of other clubs to sail on the EMBC water must accompany the visitor at all times.

Any member having a complaint concerning the conduct of another member shall put the complaint in writing.

The Committee reserve the right to terminate the membership of any member who:

A. Brings the club into disrepute.

B. Is the subject of continual complaints by others.

C. Does not abide by the club rules.

D. Does not protect their transmitter aerial.

E. Harasses the wildfowl.

All members should wear a current Club Membership Badge when on the landing stage, and at all club events. It must be worn to obtain entrance to the annual Auction Night.

Tokens must be attached to the Frequency Board to denote channels being used.

Fixed events (section and club) take precedence over individual free sailing.

Launching, sailing and recovery of models must only take place from the EMBC staging except that the model is disabled or damaged.

The use of the landing stage and rescue boat is entirely the risk & responsibility of the member(s) and their guests. The club has no responsibility for accidents.

Junior members are not permitted to bring guests onto the landing stage other than parents or guardians.

Members must wear lifejackets whilst using the rescue boat. Junior members are not permitted to use the rescue boat or be a passenger under any circumstances.

Only vessels propelled by the use of sails, electric or steam units are permitted on EMBC waters under terms of the lease. The use of fast brushless electric motors is subject to control by the committee.

At busy times or when another member has no alternative frequency and is waiting to sail, members must limit themselves to fifteen minutes on the water.

Transmitter antennae should at all times have:

a. Some form of protection at the end.

b. Colour code indication advertising the frequency in use.
